As smartphones increase in popularity, so is the use of digital wallets.

What is a digital wallet? It is a service that allows you to access money from your bank accounts, credit cards and other sources (like a PayPal account) to pay for items or send money to people with your computer, smartphone or Internet-connected device.

The convenience of having access to your money anytime, from almost anywhere and device is one of the biggest reasons the service is gaining momentum. More than 4 million Canadians already use PayPal as their digital wallet.

1. Buy goods on the go: Purchase items with your smartphone in just a few clicks. No need to enter credit card numbers, shipping addresses and billing details. You can also feel good about the fact that PayPal never shares your financial information with stores or businesses you buy from.

2. Transfer money on the spot: Quickly chip in for your exact portion of a restaurant bill. A digital wallet means that you can transfer money to your friend right at the table, without overpaying or running to an ATM.

3. Avoid ATMs and banking fees: 60 per cent of Canadians don't want to find a bank machine every time they need to pay someone back. With a digital wallet, ATMs and banking fees can be avoided. With PayPal it is free to send money to virtually anyone in Canada using your PayPal balance or bank balance.

Security Tips:

- **Passwords** – Set a password for your cell phone to lock the phone either after some period of time or inactivity or at a certain time each night.

- **Security lock Code** – Lock your phone when it is not in use.

- **Erase History** – Don't allow your cell phone to store data in your browsers for long periods of time.

- **Encrypt your information** – Encrypt your information if you must keep personal information on your phone.

- **Register your phone with the National Mobile Property Register** – This will make the process of getting your phone returned to you easier for the police. This is good for reporting a lost or stolen phone.
